#### Notice of Intent to Remediate to an **Environmental Standard**

Rotice of Intent To Remediate to an Environmental Standard. (Sections 302(e)(1)(ii), 303(h)(1)(iii), 304(n)(1)(ii), and 305(e)(1)) Pursuant to the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act (Act 2) of May 19, 1995, P.L. 4, No. 1995-2, notice is hereby given that Harley-Davidson Motor Company Operations, Inc. (Harley-Davidson) has submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) a Notice of Intent to Remediate the site located at 1425 Eden Road, Springettsbury Township, York County, York, PA 17402. This Notice of Intent to Remediate that the site has been impacted from various manufacturing and industrial operations since 1941, and was owned by York Safe & Lock Company, the U.S. Navy as the former York Naval Ordnance Plant (YNOP), and American Machine & Foundry Company (AMF). Harley-Davidson discovered that the operations of the previous owners resulted in environmental impacts to the soil and groundwater on the property. Harley-Davidson has been working under the supervision of the DEP to investigate the extent and degree of the impacts since 1984. Since 1986 Harley-Davidson has undertaken many specific remediation or cleanup activities on the site. In June of 2002, Harley-Davidson volunteered to participate with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in a Federal Facility Lead Agreement for remediation activities under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

Through these various investigations and program implementations, soil and groundwater within the site have been found to contain chlorinated solvents, including tetrachloroethene (PCE), t1,1,1-trichloroethene (TCE), 1,1,1-trichloroethene transparent compounds (vOCs). Elevated concentrations of inorganic compounds (including chromium, lead, nickel, and cyanide), polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) have also been found on the property. These compounds have impacted both soil and groundwater on the site. Harley-Davidson has indicated that final selection of remediation measures has not been completed, but will likely include use of site-specific standards for groundwater, and a combination of site-specific or statewide health standards for soils, depending upon the specific area of concern. Implementation of a site-wide Remedial Investigation (RI) is underway. The proposed future use of the property will be for commercial purposes including motorcycle fabrication and assembly operations. No residential use is contemplated. Through these various investigations and

Since Harley-Davidson may use the site-specific standard at the site, the Act provides for a 30-day public comment period for site-specific standard remediation. The 30-day comment period is initiated with the publication of this notice. Until April 25, 2005, Springettsbury Township may submit a request to Harley-Davidson to be involved in the development of the remediation and reuse plans for the site. Springettsbury Township may also submit a request to Harley-Davidson during this 30-day comment period to develop and implement a public involvement plan.
