Dear Ms. Fisher:

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the December 2, 2019 document titled "Sitewide Cleanup Plan" (report) for the property referenced above. The report was prepared by Groundwater Sciences Corporation and submitted to the DEP in accordance with the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act (Act 2) and constitutes a Cleanup Plan as defined in Chapter 3. This report was reviewed by a licensed professional geologist.

The DEP hereby approves the report in accordance with the provisions of Act 2. Please note the following comments regarding the Cleanup Plan:

- 1. On Page 36 of the report it states: "A waiver from environmental covenant, periodic assessment, and periodic notification obligations will be submitted with the Final Report for the portions of U.S. Route 30 right-of-way to the south of the Site in Lund Use Area (Lund) 5, the railroad track corridor west of the Site in Lund 6, and the levee areas along Codorus Creek to the west of the Site in Lund 5 and Lund 6." The request for waivers for these areas needs to be done in writing and before submission of the Final Report. The DEP has to approve the waivers prior to the submission of the Final Report because the post remediation care plan in it has to match the activity and use limitations proposed in the draft covenants.
- 2. The groundwater monitoring well network proposed in the Cleanup Plan may be subject to change based on the pump and treat configuration to protect surface water. The project team will need to meet and decide if the proposed network will be adequate for a site-specific groundwater attainment demonstration.

The US Environmental Protection Agency will comment on the report separately. Please contact James E. Rea, P.G. at 717.705.4850 with any questions or if further clarification is needed regarding this matter.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:
